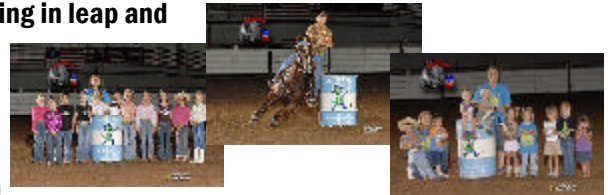
TULEY PRODUCTIONS TEAM ROPING ~ FEBRUARY 15-17

TEXAS REINING HORSE ASSOC. STAMPEDE SHOW ~ MARCH 13-16

Reining is a judged event designed to show the athletic ability of a ranch type horse within the confines of a show arena. In NRHA competition, contestants are required to run one of ten approved patterns, included in the NRHA Handbook. Each pattern includes small slow circles, large fast circles, flying lead changes, roll backs over the hocks, 360 degree spins done in place, and exciting sliding stops that are the hallmark of the reining horse.



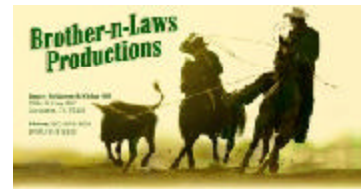
DESTINATION GLEN ROSE BRIDAL SHOW ~ MARCH 16

BROTHER-IN-LAWS TEAM ROPING ~ APRIL 5-6

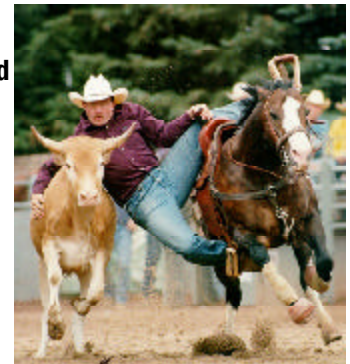
The vision started about two and a half years ago in a small central Texas back yard. Jason Bottoms and Kirby Hill ordered an arena and decided to have a few monthly jackpots. Jason is a PRCA pick-up man who has been voted twice to the Texas circuit finals and a cowboy in his spare time and Kirby is a police officer and landscaper so the team roping kinda had to fall into what ever time they had left over. They will be the first to tell you they could not have done it with out the help of there families from wife and kids to there cousin Shane. In the early fall of 2003 brother-n-laws went out on a limb and planned a roping in Athens, TX to give away 10 saddles and 10 gist buckles. Their first roping they had a little over 600 teams, which tickled them to death . You can ask either brother-n-law why they continue to put the ropings on and they'll tell you how much fun it is to see hundreds of team ropers come together and compete at a function you've worked so hard at putting together! "come rope with brother-n-laws" and you'll see we're the laid-back prize packed family team roping!



TEXAS CORRIENTE SHOW AND ROPING ~ MARCH 23-26

Corriente Cattle are used primarily as sport cattle in such events as Bulldogging and Team Roping. The breed is very hearty, Corriente Cattle can be tamed easily and to even come when called!

The Corriente can be traced back to the first cattle brought to the new world by the Spanish as early as 1493. These cattle were hardy breeds chosen especially to withstand the ocean crossing and adapt to their new land. They were brought to the West Indies and south Florida, as well as Central and South America. Over the centuries the descendants of these cattle were bred for different purposes - milk, meat and draft animals. They also adapted through natural selection to the various regions in which they lived. Eventually, their descendants spread across the southern U.S. and up the coast of California. Today, cattlemen are returning to Corriente Cattle for several reasons: They use Corriente bulls on their first calf heifers because the smaller size of Corriente calves is much easier on the first calf beef heifer. They use Corriente cattle because they tend to take much better care of a pasture by a combination of browsing and grazing rather than just grazing. Corriente cattle do not in general, have calving problems because of the smaller size of Corriente calves (usually born at about 25 lbs., the size of a cocker spaniel!). Corriente cattle can return a cash flow during the time the animals are of roping and bulldogging size. Corriente cattle are much better able to protect their own herd from predators because of their athletic agility and useful horns.
